

HACKATHON 2k21

RULEBOOK

The event will be conducted in two rounds.

Round 1:

In this round, you will be expected to submit your approach to the problem statement which you will receive in your mail on June 18 at 12:00 AM.

Round 2:

- In the 50-hour hackathon, you will have to code your proposed solution approach to make it work.
- There will be judging and mentoring sessions during the Hackathon and your solution will be under continuous evaluation.
- Do not come up with the initial codebase. All the code development should be done in the 50 hours duration only.
- All other details will be mailed directly to the qualifying teams.

Submission Format: Round 1

Guidelines:-

1. The submission must be in the specified format only. Check the Format section for detailed submission format.
2. There is no restrictions on the technologies you use for developing.

3. Plagiarism of any type will not be entertained.
4. The decision made by the judges and the organizing committee will be considered final.
5. Top solutions in Round 1 will qualify for Round 2 which is the 50-hour hackathon.
6. Once you have completed your application, click on **ADD PROJECT** on **DevFolio** and follow the format given below.

Format

Project Name: Give a name to your solution approach and write it here.

Tagline: Explain your approach in brief.

The problem it solves: State the features you include your app/website point-wise and explain how they solve the problem or why you have included them.

Challenges I ran into: Showstoppers/Limitations of your solution approach or the problems you might ran into while coding.

Technologies used: List the technologies you plan on using if you get selected in Round 2.

Links: Write your descriptive methodology in Google Doc in not more than 2000 words. Please share the link to the document in this section while making your submission on DevFolio and make sure its access is open to all. You can also add images or any visual illustration you find necessary for the understanding of your solution in the Google Doc itself.

Video Demo: If you wish to explain your solution through video, you can create one but not more than 5 minutes. Note that this section is totally optional.

Pictures: This section is optional. If you want to add some pictures, it is preferable to add them along with your Google document.

Note - For Front-end, wireframes can also be included in Google Doc made using Adobe xD, Balsamiq, Figma, etc. It will help to explain your front-end design better.

Note - There is a comments section in DevFolio. Please keep yourself updated with this particular section and make the changes accordingly.

How to submit

Once you have completed writing your idea in the format given above, follow the instructions given below:-

1. Click on “Preview Submission” button.

2. Click on “Save Project” button.
3. Click on “Edit” button if you wish to make changes in your current project.
4. Click on “Delete” if you wish to create a whole new submission.
5. Click on “Submit project or judging” once you have completed the project. **Note** that you cannot make any changes once you click this button.

Participation Criteria

- There can be 1-4 members in one team.
- Members of a team can be from the same as well as different years and colleges.
- Anyone who is enrolled in UG/PG course in any college/university across the world is eligible to participate.
